Competition Rules and Regulations

The Garden State Journalists Association’s annual journalism competition honors the best in print, online and broadcast journalism. In 2020, we celebrate our 73rd year of recognizing excellence in our field.

The GSJA journalism contest is open to all reporters, editors, broadcast journalists, photographers and public relations professionals who live, work in or write about New Jersey. All entries must have been published in the calendar year 2019, and may be submitted by the individual or individuals who produced the work - or their editors. A team effort may be entered.

INSTRUCTIONS:

To enter the competition, complete the accompanying entry form and staple it to the front of the article, photograph, DVD or CD. Articles do not have to be mounted on cardboard backing. If there are multiple articles on the page you are submitting, please highlight the headline of the article being entered with a marker. If a story jumps, please submit the full “continued from” page on which the article continues. For online entries, the entire URL of where the article was published must be shown.

For news articles, we are accepting the actual publication, copies, PDF printouts, wire service copy and printed webpages. The date of publication must appear somewhere on the page.

Headline competition entries MUST be accompanied by the stories for which they were written. Series or multiple entries MUST be permanently secured to avoid separation.

All photos must be prints, at least 8 x 10, mounted on 11 x 14 photo boards. Editorial cartoons must also be mounted on cardboard.

Video entries MUST be on DVDs with labels on the disc. CDs of podcasts and radio entries also must be labeled.

Note: The same entry may not be entered in more than one category.

A maximum of SIX entries per person, per category, is permitted, EXCEPT for categories 48-54, where the maximum is THREE entries.

The fee per entry is \$10. Please enclose your check, payable to Garden State Journalists Association, and place it in an envelope and attach it to the front of the entry form with a paper clip.

All entries and payment must be received ON OR BEFORE MARCH 27, 2020, to be considered valid.
